Entry requirements

The student must be admitted to the PhD Programme in Psychology.

Learning outcomes

A student who successfully completes the course should be able to:

Knowledge and understanding

- demonstrate a systematic understanding of the principles of, and different forms of, scientific communication within the field of psychological science

Skills and abilities

- demonstrate skills in independently completing different types of presentations, such as scientific articles, abstracts and posters
- complete and be responsible for scientific discussions, presentations and popular science presentations

Judgment and approach

- show the ability to make his/her own judgements about scientific communication in speech and writing

Content

This is a skills course, designed to introduce the doctoral student to the communicative practices in psychological science. The course's different sections are designed to provide familiarity with, and experience of, different forms of presentation related to research.

Form of teaching

Teaching will take place through the PhD student's participation in different activities which involve scientific communication (see the attached checklist).

Language of instruction

The language of instruction is Swedish, but the course can be delivered in English if necessary.

Grades

The grading scale comprises: Pass (G) and Fail (U).

Forms of assessment

The course is examined individually through a certificate of completed activities according to the attached checklist. The course coordinator makes an assessment of the completed activities, and makes a decision on the final grade.

Course evaluation

The course coordinator is responsible to ensuring that students have the opportunity to complete a course evaluation at the end of the course. The course evaluation is summarized and presented in FUB.

Additional information

The main supervisor is responsible for ensuring that the PhD student has the opportunity to complete the various aspects of the course during his/her education. The Postgraduate studies officer is responsible for archiving the checklist and the attachments which confirm completion of the activities. The Postgraduate studies officer is also responsible for reporting the course credits in Ladok.

Registration for the course is made with the Postgraduate studies officer at the Department of Psychology.
